Three Things that Caused Uzziah to Prosper in the Beginning

1.	Uzziah God	- 2 Chronicles 26:4 (NLT), "+ He did what was pleasing in the	
	LORD's sight, just as his father, Amaziah, had done."		
2.	Uzziah God-	2 Chronicles 26:5 (NLT), "sUzziah sought God during the days	
	of Zechariah, who taught him to fear God."		
3.	Uzziah	because of God- 2 Chronicles 26:5b (NLT), "And as long as	
	the king sought guidance from the LORD, God gave him success."		
Three Things that Caused Uzziah to Fall at the End			
1.	He ignored God's	2 Chronicles 26:16 (NLT), "16 But when he had become	
	powerful, he also became proud, i	which led to his downfall. He sinned against the LORD his God	
	by entering the sanctuary of the LORD's Temple and personally burning incense on the incense

2.	He ignored	counsel-2 Chronicles 26:17-18 (NLT), "17 Azariah the high	
	priest went in after him with eighty other priests of the LORD, all brave men. ¹⁸ They confronted King Uzziah and said, "It is not for you, Uzziah, to burn incense to the LORD. That		
	is the work of the priests alone,	the work of the priests alone, the descendants of Aaron who are set apart for this work.	
	Get out of the sanctuary, for you	have sinned. The LORD God will not honor you for this!"	
3.	He thought he was beyond	2 Chronicles 26:19 (NLT), "19Uzziah, who	
	was holding an incense burner, be	came furious. But as he was standing there raging at the	
	priests before the incense altar in the LORD's Temple, leprosy suddenly broke out on his forehead."
