was in the hinde	r part of the ship, asle	ep on a pillow: and they awake
him, and say unt	o him, Master, carest	thou not that we perish?"
4. There is always	an <u>assurance</u>	Mark 4:39, " <sup>39</sup> And
he arose, and re	buked the wind, and so	id unto the sea, Peace, be still.
And the wind ce	ased, and there was a	great calm. 40 And he said unto
them, Why are y	ve so fearful? how is it	that ye have no faith? <sup>41</sup> And
they feared exc	eedingly, and said one	to another, What manner of mar
is this, that ever	n the wind and the sea	obey him?"
